## 2009 Kentucky Communication Association Conference

The Kentucky Communication Association invites submissions for the 2009 conference. We encourage submissions from students as well as from colleagues at colleges and universities, high schools, and communication and communication-related professions.

### Conference Theme: "Be the Change"

Gandhi's words "Be the change you want to see in the world" are often quoted. This expression challenges individuals to enact self-presentations and behaviors that are consistent with individual and social goals. The communication discipline is uniquely positioned to examine change—individual, group, and cultural transformation. This year's conference theme invites examination of communication and change. Submissions on a wide variety of interpretations of the theme are encouraged. In addition, submissions in areas outside the conference theme also will be considered.

#### Submission Deadline:

March 15, 2009 for **non-student authors**

May 1, 2009 for **student authors**

Proposals for presentation should include name, affiliation, e-mail address, phone number, a descriptive title for the presentation, and a brief description (e.g., for papers include an abstract of not more than 75 words, for panels include descriptive details of theme and presenter contributions).

A variety of presentation types will be considered (e.g., papers, panels, roundtable discussions, G.I.F.T.S. or Great Ideas for Teaching Speech, performances, workshops or short courses, poster sessions).
